

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS Albert Szent-Györgyi Scholarship 2020

FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS STUDYING IN THE FOREIGN LANGUAGE MEDICAL PROGRAMS OF THE FACULTY OF MEDICINE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SZEGED

The aim of the scholarship

The aim of the scholarship is to aid the highest-performing students partaking in the foreign language medical program.

Conditions of the scholarship

Regular Support

The amount of the scholarship is HUF 40.000 per month for a period of 10 months (in the academic year 2020/2021: from September 2020 to the end of June 2021), HUF 400.000 altogether.

The scholarship will be awarded to top 15 applicants.

Eligibility

- Outstanding study average in compulsory subjects in the second semester of the academic year 2019/2020: the students' academic performance (semester average) in compulsory subjects needs to reach at least 90% (4,50) out of the maximum 100% (5,00).
- Study progress made according to the suggested study plan.
- Students who have been granted the National Higher Education Scholarship are not eligible for the scholarship.
- Active student status at the Faculty of Medicine in the first semester of the academic year 2020/2021
- Having no outstanding tuition fee debt at the time of application

Preconditions

Students applying for the Scholarship have to submit the completed Application Form (Appendix 1) and the necessary supporting documentation (e.g. proving one's extracurricular scientific or sport activity) until August 3, 2020.

Support period

September 2020 – June 2021

One student is entitled to submit only one scholarship application within the framework of the present tender.

Non-eligibility

The fund will be denied from the applicant if

- a) the application submitted contains false or deceptive data in the declaration or otherwise,
- b) the applicant deviates from the stipulations laid down in the contract without express permission while the project is ongoing,
- c) the applicant is involved in any irreconcilable condition regarding the stipulations defined in 6. § (1) and 8. § (1) of Act CLXXXI of 2007 on the Transparency of state aids provided from Public Funds (henceforth referred to as Knyt.) and does not initiate the publication of said condition by the deadline defined in Knyt..

Application procedure

All applications shall be submitted via e-mail to etr.fs@med.u-szeged.hu.

Only complete applications are accepted.

Submission deadline

August 3, 2020

All applications complying with the above requirements are accepted.

Validity of the application

All applications complying with the above requirements are considered valid.

Evaluation of the application, selection criteria

All applications complying with the above requirements are evaluated. One can obtain a maximum of 100 points. The evaluation is based on the following aspects:

- 1.) Outstanding Academic Performance in the second semester of the academic year 2019/2020: max. 60 points
- 2.) Demonstrator Activity (please attach a proof to your application): 3 points/semester
- 3.) Scientific Circle (henceforth TDK) (please attach a proof to your application): max 5 points
 - TDK Membership (TDK Regulations, 2/5: "Students can participate in only one TDK at a time, but can collaborate with other institutes".): 2 points/ semester
 - TDK research paper (TDK pályamunka): 3 points
 - Participation in the annual TDK Conference of the Faculty: 1 point
 - 3rd prize award at the TDK Conference: 2 points
 - 2nd prize award at the TDK Conference: 3 points
 - 1st prize award at the TDK Conference: 4 points
 - 3rd prize award at National Conference of Students' Research Circles (henceforth OTDK): 3 points
 - 2nd prize award at the OTDK Conference: 4 points
 - 1st prize award at the OTDK Conference: 5 points

In case the student was awarded a prize at the TDK/OTDK Conference, no extra points will be granted for the participation.

- 4.) Participation in a Hungarian scientific conference as first author during the applicant's studies at the University of Szeged (*please attach a proof to your application*): **2 points/paper**
- 5.) Participation in an international scientific conference as first author during the applicant's studies at the University of Szeged (*please attach a proof to your application*): **4 points/paper**
- 6.) Proofread publication in a Hungarian journal as first author during the applicant's studies at the University of Szeged (please attach a proof to your application): 2 points/ paper
- 7.) Proofread publication in an international journal as first author during the applicant's studies at the University of Szeged, e.g. PubMed (please attach a proof to your application):

 3 points/ paper
- 8.) Active participation in other conferences (e.g. holding a presentation) during the applicant's studies at the University of Szeged (*please attach a proof to your application*): 1 point/ conference

- 9.) Emergency medical technician qualification obtained at the University of Szeged during the applicant's studies (*please attach a proof to your application*): **4 points**
- 10.) Other (please attach a proof to your application: max. 5 points)
 - ISUS board membership: 2 points
 - Regular university sport activity (e.g. "Medikus kupa"): 1 point
 - Organizing an event related to university life: 1 point
 - Voluntary work that contributed to the Faculty's development: 1 point

Notification

Decisions are announced by the Foreign Students' Secretariat. In case of rejections, detailed justification will be provided.
