Calculation method for the diploma average: $XD = \frac{Xn + D + I + Sz + Gy}{n + 4}$

Where XD = diploma average,

Xn = the sum of the grades given to examinations and comprehensive examinations,

D = the grade awarded to the thesis,

I = the grade awarded to the written part (test) of the examination,

Sz = the grade awarded to the oral part of the patient examination,

Gy = the grade awarded to the practical part of the patient examination,

n = the number of examinations and comprehensive examinations prescribed.
