Mobility support for SZTE Albert Szent-Györgyi Medical School students

Who can apply:

- ✓ Full-time undergraduate students enrolled at SZTE Albert Szent-Györgyi Medical School in the current academic year,
- √ has not repeated a semester in either of the two semesters preceding the submission of the application,
- ✓ has a weighted grade point average above 3.51 in the previous two semesters,
- √ has not received a mobility grant in the current academic year and has received one mobility
 grant during his studies, and
 - is to participate a scholarship (part-time course) abroad or
 - has been accepted for an internship abroad, or
 - has a presentation or poster accepted for a professional/scientific conference.

What to attach:

- 1. mobility application form
- 2. SZTE Student Mobility Grant Contract
- 3. Student Mobility Grant Supplementary Form
- 4. detailed motivation letter in English and/or in the language of the placement (max. 1 page)
- 5. detailed, goal-oriented work plan in English and language of the placement (max. 1 page)
- 6. copy of invitation letter
- 7. 2 recommendation letters of Medical School teachers
- 8. certificates:
 - i. index extracts from the last two completed semesters (available from the Academic Office)
 - ii. copies of the language examination certificate(s)
 - iii. certificate of student research activity from the supervisor (student scientific work, conference participation)
 - iv. certificate of demonstrator activity

Not required, but may be put in the application documentation:

- v. student union activity (exact name and duration of the activity)
- vi. list of other student work or achievements during the academic years; any work that the student considers important for the application to be considered favourably

How to submit:

- Applications can be handed in at the Dean's Office of Albert Szent-Györgyi Medical School (109 Tisza L. krt), to Kornélia Szűcs-Tettinger, Monday-Thursday from 8 am to 4 pm, Friday from 8 am to 1 pm
- Applications can be submitted at any time up to 3 months before the planned departure and up to 1 month after the return.

- Applications are assessed by the Faculty Student Mobility Committee, which meets at least 3 times a year and decides on the applications.

Other actions to be taken:

In case of a positive decision, you will have to submit a certificate of the completed internship, the opinion of the consultant doctor (to whom you were assigned) and <u>your report on the internship</u> to the Dean's Office. The internship report is required in English (or the language of the internship). The awarded grant will be transferred only <u>after</u> proof of the internship or conference participation.
