## Requirements in Microbiology II. for 3<sup>rd</sup> year medical students Academic year 2018/2019. Fall term

## **<u>1. Participation in lectures and practicals</u>**

Attendance at lectures will be considered in the final exam (positive consideration, opportunity to change one picked topic in the final exam). Participation in practicals is **compulsory**. In case of absence from more than 25% of practicals (for any reason) the head of the department **will refuse to sign** the book of study certificates. Less than 25% absences can be justified by doctors certificate, etc. (see Study Rules). The presence at lectures (>80%) will enable the students to change one topic in the exam.

## 2. Mid-semester examination

There will be <u>one</u> examination (test: simple and multiple choice) covering lectures as well as practices. Once you may **repeat** the test. Participation on the MTO is compulsory and the result will be considered in the final examination:

- student, who has failed on the MTO (<50%) get one more topic from detailed bacteriology in the final exam.
- student, who has reached more than 80 % on the MTO can pick 2 topics from detailed bacteriology and answer only the prefered one in the final exam.

Date of the MTO: 8<sup>th</sup> of November 2018 in the Lecture Hall, after the lecture.

## **<u>3. End-semester examination</u>**

The oral examination is based on the material studied during the semester (lectures, practicals) and on the textbook (L. P. Samaranayake: Essential Microbiology for Dentistry, Churchill Livingstone, Practical classes in medical microbiology and immunology edited by Rozália Pusztai, SZOTE, 2002).

There will be 4 topics in the examination: general microbiology and immunology, bacteriology, virology, parasitic and fungal diseases
