

Requirements in Microbiology II. for 3rd year medical students

Academic year 2018/2019.

Fall term

1. Participation in lectures and practicals

Attendance at lectures will be considered in the final exam (positive consideration, opportunity to change one picked topic in the final exam). Participation in practicals is **compulsory**. In case of absence from more than 25% of practicals (for any reason) the head of the department **will refuse to sign** the book of study certificates. Less than 25% absences can be justified by doctors certificate, etc. (see Study Rules). The presence at lectures (>80%) will enable the students to change one topic in the exam.

2. Mid-semester examination

There will be one examination (test: simple and multiple choice) covering lectures as well as practices. Once you may **repeat** the test. Participation on the MTO is compulsory and the result will be considered in the final examination:

- student, who has failed on the MTO (<50%) get one more topic from detailed bacteriology in the final exam.
- student, who has reached more than 80 % on the MTO can pick 2 topics from detailed bacteriology and answer only the preferred one in the final exam.

Date of the MTO: 8th of November 2018 in the Lecture Hall, after the lecture.

3. End-semester examination

The oral examination is based on the material studied during the semester (lectures, practicals) and on the textbook (L. P. Samaranayake: **Essential Microbiology for Dentistry**, Churchill Livingstone, **Practical classes in medical microbiology and immunology** edited by Rozália Pusztai, SZOTE, 2002).

There will be 4 topics in the examination: general microbiology and immunology, bacteriology, virology, parasitic and fungal diseases
