

Requirements in microbiology and immunology for 3rd year pharmacy students

Academic year 2018/2019.

Fall term

1. Participation in lectures and practicals

Attendance at lectures will be considered in the final exam (positive consideration, opportunity to change one picked topic in the final exam). Participation in practicals is **compulsory**. If students are absent from more than 25% of the practicals (for any reason) the head of the department will **refuse to sign** the book of study certificates. If you miss less than 25% of the practicals the absence can be justified (by doctors certificate, etc.).

2. Mid-semester examination:

There will be **one** examination (test: simple and multiple choice questions) covering lectures. Once you may repeat the test. Participation on the MTO is compulsory and the result will be considered in the evaluation of the final exam.

- student, who has failed on the MTO (<50%) get one more topic in the final exam.
- student, who has reached more than 80 % on the MTO can change 1 topic in the final exam.

3. Final examination

The oral examination is based on the material studied during the semester (lectures, practicals) and on the textbook (Levinson, **Review of Medical Microbiology and Immunology**, Lange Med. Publ., 11th ed., 2010; **Practical classes in medical microbiology and immunology** edited by Rozália Pusztai, SZOTE, 2002).
