## Requirements in Microbiology for 3<sup>rd</sup> year medical students Academic year 2018/2019. Spring term

## **<u>1. Participation in lectures and practices</u>**

Attendance at lectures will be considered in the end-semester examination (positive consideration, + 3 points). Participation in practices is **compulsory**. In case of absence from more than 25% (for any reason) the head of the department **will refuse to sign** the book of study certificates. Less than 25% absences can be justified by doctor's certificate, etc. (see Study Rules).

## 2. Mid-semester examination

There will be <u>one</u> written examination covering lectures as well as practices. Once you may **repeat** the test. The result of the MTO will be considered in the end-semester examination:
